

According to Serkis, who is currently shooting Peter Jackson's *The Hobbit*, those wearing motion capture suits were treated differently from everyone else! "In the *Planet of the Apes* documentary they talked about how the orangutans hung out with the other orangutans, the chimps hung out with the chimps, and the gorillas hung out with the gorillas," Serkis tells *Showbiz Spy*. "And to a certain extent there was a little bit of that shooting this movie. We tended to knock around together." What he's referring to is the late Charlton Heston's oft-told story of the way that actors dressed as chimps, gorillas and orangutans tended to center around each other, creating a sense of segregation on the set of the original *Planet of the Apes*.

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
